The Christmas market will be running from Thursday 19th November to Tuesday 22nd December, open every day from 10am-6pm (Sunday to Wednesday) and 10am-7.30pm from Thursday to Saturday.

Meanwhile, the Tourist Information Centre is hosting the Winchester Charity Christmas Card volunteers for the second year.
